### **Message from Matt**

As we head into the New Year, it is a great time to reflect on the start of our inaugural season. 374 teams representing six states and thirty-one clubs took a chance on our new league when we started on August 13, 2021. Since then, we have had over 2,450 AHF games across four states. The players have scored over 20,000 goals (and counting) during the 115,000 minutes of play so far this season.

While the numbers are impressive, next year will be even better. We have decided to move from a supplemental league to a full-time league. Most of our teams will leave the DVHL and NJYHL; a small number of teams will play full time in the NJYHL and CBHL while continuing to play a supplemental schedule in the AHF. The response from the hockey community has been excellent. We had over 25 organizations that wanted to join us. We decided to stay true to our mission of rink owned/controlled clubs and are proud to welcome the following new members for the 2022-2023 season:

- Independent Clubs: The Wilkes Barre Scranton Knights, Pittston, PA and Tomorrow's Ice, Abingdon, MD

We are lucky to have all of these outstanding clubs join us next year.

We experimented with a bunch of new things, some of which worked well (GameSheet and Scouting Reports) and some of which were not so good and will not continue (HockeyTV). Our promise to you is that we will innovate and bring new things to provide our hockey families a great experience. We are bound to make mistakes but will learn from them and continue to improve, just as our players do each time they step on the ice. Playoffs are coming up in the next few weeks, and we are looking forward to crowning our inaugural champions.

## 18U, 16U and 14U AA Playoff Preview

The Atlantic Hockey Federation will kick off its first post-season playoffs at the 18U AA, 16U AA, and 14U AA levels on Saturday, January 15th, at the Northeast Skate Zone in Philadelphia, PA, and will culminate with championship games on Sunday, January 16th. The top six teams from each division will compete in a round-robin format, with the round-robin winner and the round-robin runner up facing each other in championship games to crown the first-ever U18 AA, U16 AA, and U14 AA Atlantic Hockey Federation Champions.

The 18U AA division features some of the strongest teams in the country. Presently, four of the top five teams in the AHF 18U AA standings are ranked in the top 30 nationally: Ashburn Xtreme #5, MYHA Blue #16, Philadelphia Blazers #20, and the Igloo Jaguars #26. Based on the results in the regular season, these are going to be some great competitive hockey games, and the champion will have beaten a number of outstanding hockey teams in a weekend to be crowned 2021-2022 AHF champion.

The 16U AA division is presently led in the standings by Team Philadelphia, ranked #8 nationally. The road to the 16U AA championship will be difficult as currently, each team in the top six of the standings has won at least 10 games on the season. This division's depth of talent and quality will be on display this weekend as the top six in the AHF regular-season rankings feature two teams from Maryland, two teams from New Jersey, and two teams from Pennsylvania.

The 14U AA division standings are presently led by the New Jersey Rockets, who are ranked 8th in the nation. Expect to see some high-scoring games in the round-robin phase of the 14U AA division playoffs. Each team currently in the top six in the AHF rankings is averaging over four goals per game, led by the North Jersey Aspen Kings Blue team averaging over seven goals per game.
